Active in politics, a member of the Newton Democratic City Committee, delegate to the State Nominating Committee, co-chair of the Newton Events Committee of Barney Frank's Congressional Campaign, Lillian truly believed in the political process.

As Assistant to the Superintendent of the Newton Public Schools, 1972-1983, Lillian was involved in virtually every aspect of the development, review, and implementation of the programs, policies, plans, and budgets for the Newton Public Schools. In this role, she taught by example. She felt education was Newton's most important product and she fought long and hard for public education everywhere. In addition to her work and political life, she always found the time to be a caring parent, grandparent, friend, and mentor.
